



## EHS Site Certifications

The foundation of Pfizer’s EHS program is robust EHS management systems. Pfizer EHS programs, applicable to all operations globally, place an emphasis on identifying and managing EHS risk. The programs are described within Global EHS Standards structured very similarly to the ISO14001 framework; with implementation at our sites verified through the Pfizer internal EHS audit program.

Pfizer recognizes that external certifications (for example ISO14001, OHSAS 18001, OSHA VPP) play a role in assuring performance, but certification does not benefit all sites equally. We evaluate on a case by case basis to determine whether certification would bring benefit to a site. Our internal EHS audit program is used to inform these decisions, and provide assurance of robust EHS management systems at all sites.
