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**Important Information Regarding Bacitracin
(bacitracin for injection, USP)**

Pfizer Injectables' Bacitracin is manufactured from two different sources of active pharmaceutical ingredients (API), one of them being a new source of API. Bacitracin using the new API appears lighter in color in both the powder form and the reconstituted solution. The powder is white to pale buff. The reconstituted solution should be clear and free of particulates. Based on Pfizer's evaluations, all distributed lots continue to be acceptable for use regardless of observed color variations, dissolution time differences, or degree of foam in Bacitracin produced from the two sources of API.

All Bacitracin presentations are impacted by this new source of API resulting in the color change. For your convenience, the presentations are reflected in the chart below:
